

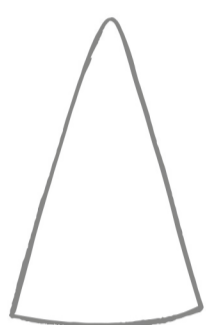

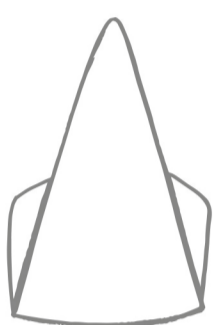
My name is Edie and I am ever so helpful!

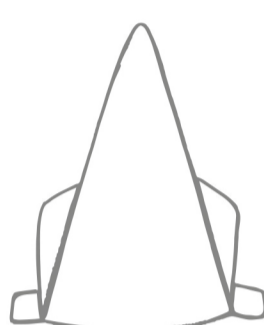
Got them? Great! Lets go!...



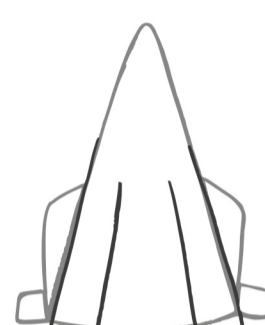
Start by drawing a cone shape lightly in pencil.



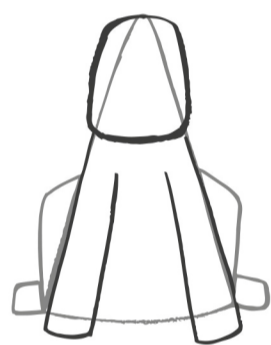
Now add two triangles either side also lightly in pencil.



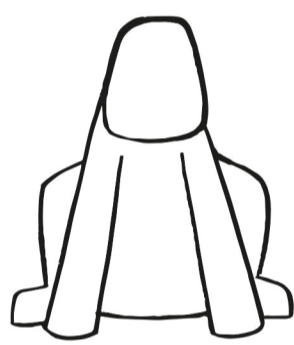
And add two little squarish shapes like this (also lightly in pencil).



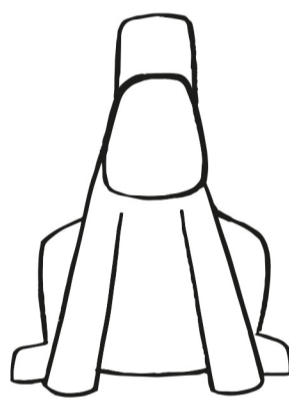
Now you can use a heavy pencil! Woo Hoo! Add two long tubes for legs...



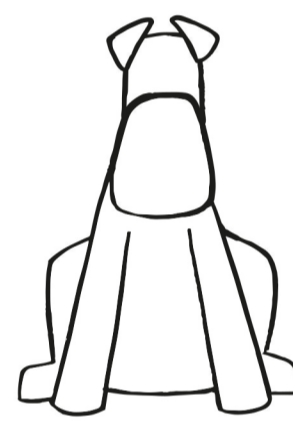
Add a squarish shape with rounded corners here...



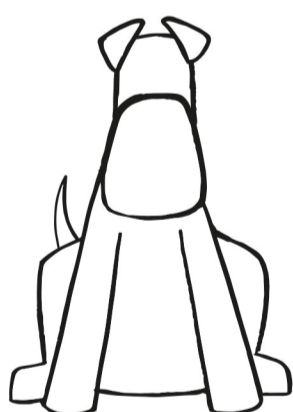
Now use the heavy pencil to outline the other shapes like this, and rub out the light bits left over.



Add another squarish shape with rounded corners above the first one.



And two triangles, one on each top corner (these will be his ears!).



Of course he needs a tail so we know when he is happy!



Now for some COLOUR! You can colour your dog any colour you like, but mine is blue!



Add another triangle here for his nose!



And two ovals for his eyes here...



Draw the bottom half of a circle under his nose, so he's smiling!



And a top half of a circle above each eye for eyebrows, like this!...T'DA!

HOORAY! You've done ever such excellent drawing and drawn a terrrrific dog! Hmmm. But I think we could make him look even more terrrrific! Maybe we could jazz him up a little? I don't think you can ever have enough pom poms, bows and twinkly stars...
