Top tips for having fun with rhymes



- 1** Say the rhymes slowly at first. This will help your child really hear and learn the different words and give them time to join in. Increase the speed when your child knows the rhyme!

- 2** Don't worry if your child doesn't join in at first. It's good for them to listen, too.

- 3** When you say the rhymes it helps your child if they can see your face and how you move your mouth.

- 4** Change your voice as you say the rhymes. Make it loud or quiet, fast or slow or high and low. Ask your child to change their voice, too. This will help them learn to listen.

- 5** When your child knows the rhyme, let them finish the line themselves. Stop and let them say the rest!

- 6** Don't worry if you're not a fluent Welsh speaker – give the Welsh rhymes a go and have some fun!

- 4** Newidiwch eich llais wrth i chi ddweud y rhigymau. Gwnewch lais swnllyd neu dawel, cyflym neu araf, uchel neu isel. Gofynnwch i'ch plentyn newid ei lais hefyd. Bydd hyn yn ei helpu i ddysgu gwrando.

- 5** Pan fydd eich plentyn yn gwybod y rhigwm, gadewch iddo orffen y llinell ei hun. Stopiwch a gadewch i'r plentyn ddweud y gweddill!
