 In his little house



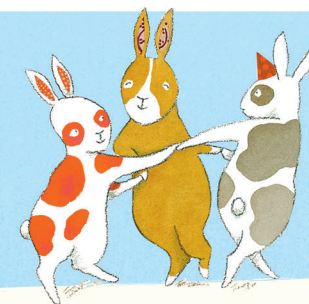
