- Why not use this as an opportunity to invite parents and carers to join in the fun and attend your exclusive classroom disco!
- Let your pupils fully enjoy the book by getting them bouncing, rhyming, dancing and acting out the movements and sounds of the fruits as you read the story. You could even get them to choose their favourite fruit that they want to be!
- To really get the party started, don't forget to make use of the fantastic official Kitchen Disco YouTube sing along video that can be found here: http://bit.ly/2ciBDOP. Turn the lights down and the music up and let the children sing along!
- How about making up some of your own movements and rhymes for the fruits in the story or even some that aren't included.
- Let the children take part in some fruit tasting activities (you could even make some rainbow fruit cups using our step by step instructions).
- Get your students to create some of their own fruity designs by cutting different fruits in half, dipping them in paint and printing on paper.
- Repeat, repeat! The disco doesn't have to stop here, make sure you encourage children and their families to share the story over and over again at home.
