
## CHAPTER 2: Halftime

~~With Jordan~~


While waiting for her mum to pick her up from school, she noticed a football in the playground.

imagined she was playing on the school team at the tournament with Jordan and the other boys.


She imagined a crowd cheering her name Kev-e-na Kev-ena Kev-e-na. She was finally playing football!
