
Make your own top trumps

Below are six cards. On each of them, draw a member of your very own imaginary rugby team. Underneath, you will give them scores from 1-5 in different categories.


The categories are: Speed, Strength, Footwork, Tackling, Agility

When you have created your deck, pair up with the person next to you and play a game of Top Trumps.



The objective is to win all the cards.
