


Activity idea:

## Make your own ladybird





## You will need

- A cup or jar
- A sheet of paper
- Child-friendly scissors
- Colouring pencils/pens
- Step 1 Take your cup and place it in the middle of the paper.
   Draw an outline around it thats your ladybird's body! You can also download an outline of a ladybird here
- Step 2 Draw a line down the middle, small circles on its body, a
  head and legs. Try asking your child to describe their ladybird
  and what they're doing at each step
- Step 3 Cut out the ladybird and colour it in whatever colours your child chooses
- Step 4 You could also try making a family of minibeasts by making smaller or bigger ladybirds, or have a go at making other minibeasts such as beetles or ants.
