


### **The Cat and the King, Nick Sharratt** (Scholastic) ISBN 9781407135090


### **Superhero Snap! Card Game** (Laurence King) ISBN 9781786271341


### **Doodle Adventures: The Rise of the Rusty Robo-Cat!** Mike Lowery (Melia) ISBN 9780761187219


**King Flashypants and the Boo-Hoo Witches, Andy Riley (Hachette) ISBN 9781444940978**




**Life on Earth: Ocean (Quarto) ISBN 9781786030573**


**The Invincible Tony Spears, Neal Layton (Hachette) ISBN 9781444919523**




