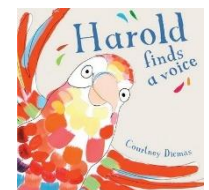
My First Joke Book (*Arcturus*) ISBN 9781788285193

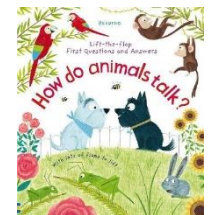
Harold Finds a Voice, Courtney Dicmas (*Child's Play*) ISBN 9781846435492

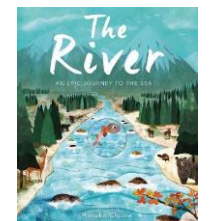
Lift-the-Flap First Questions and Answers: How Do Animals Talk? (*Usborne*) ISBN 9781474940085

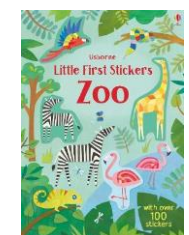
The River, Patricia Hegarty & Hanako Clulow (*Little Tiger*) ISBN 9781848576667

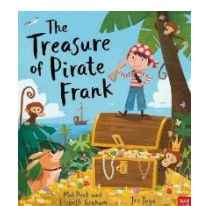
Little First Stickers: Zoo (*Usborne*) ISBN 9781474950978

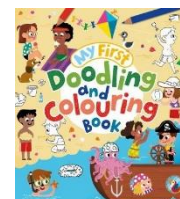
Look and Find Bugs (Usborne) ISBN 9781474937450

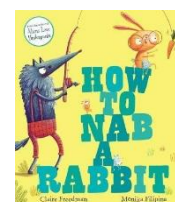
My First Drawing, Doodling and Colouring Book (Arcturus) ISBN 9781784288129

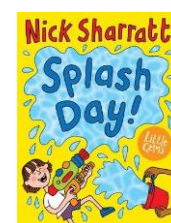
Emma Jane's Aeroplane, Katie Haworth & Daniel Rieley (Templar) ISBN 9781783708406
