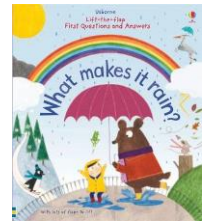

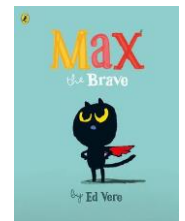
### **Lift-the-Flap First Questions and Answers: What Makes it Rain?** (Usborne) ISBN 9781409598817

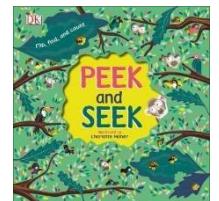
### **Max the Brave, Ed Vere** (Penguin Random House) ISBN 9780723286707

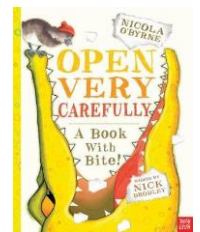
### **Peek and Seek, Charlotte Milner** (Dorling Kindersley) ISBN 9780241313046

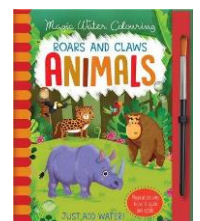
### **Open Very Carefully, Nick Bronley & Nicola O'Byrne** (Nosy Crow) ISBN 9780857630841

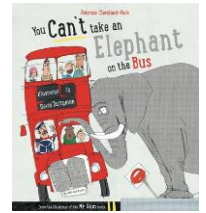
### **Magic Water Colouring: Roars and Claws Animals** (Imagine That) ISBN 9781787009622

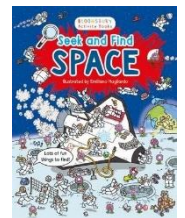
**My Very First Space Book (Usborne) ISBN 9781409582007**

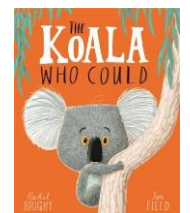
**Seek and Find Space, Emiliano Magliardo (Bloomsbury) ISBN 9781408870037**

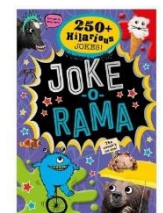
**The Koala Who Could, Rachel Bright, Jim Field (Hachette) ISBN 9781408331644**

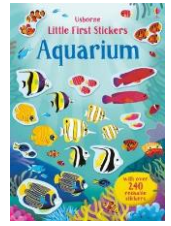
**In the Swamp by the Light of the Moon, Frann Preston-Gannon (Bonnier) ISBN 9781787413863**
