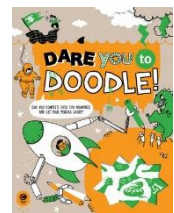
Dog Man, Dav Pilkey (Scholastic) ISBN 9781407140391

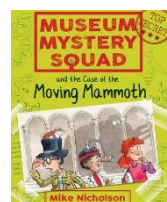
Night Zoo Keeper - The Giraffes of Whispering Wood, Joshua Davidson (Oxford University Press) ISBN 9780192764058

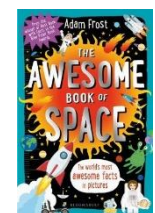
Museum Mystery Squad and the Case of the Moving Mammoth, Mike Nicholson (Floris) ISBN 9781782503613

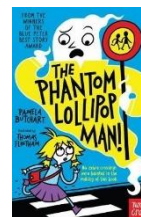
Weird But True! Cool and Crazy Sticker Doodle Book (National Geographic Kids) ISBN 9781426330230

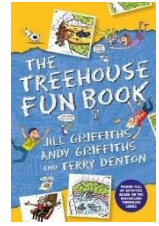

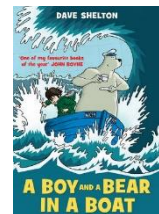
