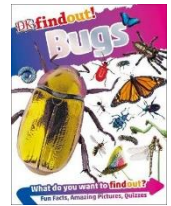

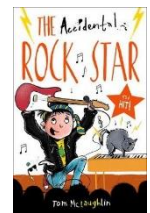
DK Find Out! Bugs (Dorling Kindersley) ISBN 9780241284735

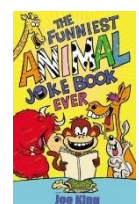
The Nothing To See Here Hotel, Steve Butler & Steve Lenton (Simon & Schuster) ISBN 9781471163838

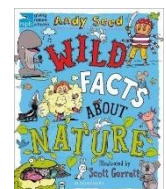

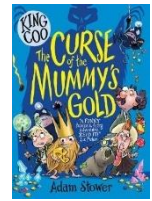
Wild Facts About Nature, Andy Seed & Scott Garrett (Bloomsbury) ISBN 9781408891872

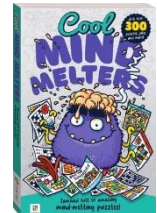
King Coo: The Curse of the Mummy's Gold, Adam Stower (*David Fickling Books*) ISBN 9781788450522

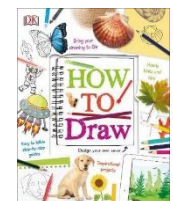

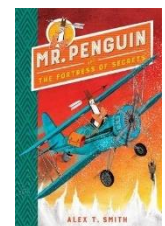
How to Draw (*Dorling Kindersley*) ISBN 9780241282489

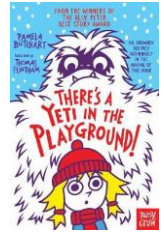
Everything Sharks (*National Geographic*) ISBN 9780008267759
