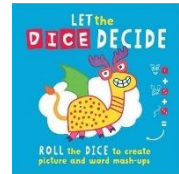


Letterbox Yellow (age 7-9) 2019 Book Selection

With the cards divided equally and held face down, players turn over their top cards into a pile in the middle. 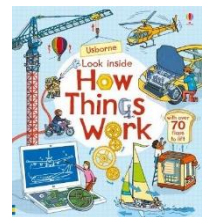
T. Rex Time Machine, Jared Chapman (*Abrams & Chronicle*) ISBN 9781452161549

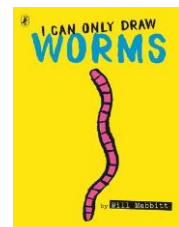
Look Inside How Things Work (*Usborne*) ISBN 9781474936576

I Can Only Draw Worms, Will Mabbitt (*Penguin Random House*) ISBN 9780141375182

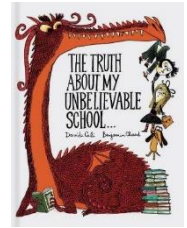

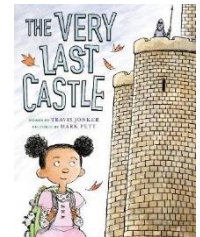
National Geographic Kids: Weird But True Sticker Doodle Book *(National Geographic)* ISBN 9781426324567

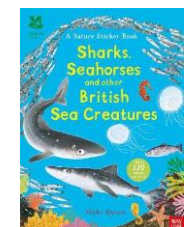
The Very Last Castle, Jonker Travis *(Abrams & Chronicle) ISBN 9781419725746*

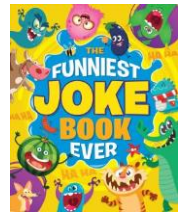
Mortimer Keene: Dino Danger, Tim Healey & Chris Mould *(Hachette) ISBN 9781444919691*

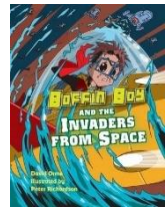
Freezing Poles (Macmillan) ISBN 9780753438916
