


# Oh deer!

1

Draw an oval. Add a large “U” shape over the top of the oval. Draw a smaller “U” inside the first. Then add neck lines below the oval.

Turn the “U” shapes into antlers by drawing curved lines around them. Then add detail lines to the oval head and the neck.

Draw leaf shapes for ears on both sides of the head. Use scalloped lines to add some hair. Give the reindeer a nose. Then add detail lines to the collar to make it look 3-D.





Add detail lines to the ears. Give the reindeer eyes, eyebrows and a mouth. Finally, add two bells to its collar.

# Skating fun


Winter brings cold weather. But don't let that stop the fun. Draw a funny penguin playing on the ice.

Draw an oval with one pointed end. Draw curved lines where the arms and legs should be.



2

Draw a smaller oval inside the first. Then draw half ovals as feet. Round off the arms. Add detail and scalloped lines to the head to make a hat.



3

Give the penguin eyes. Draw curved lines to start the beak and add detail above the eyes. Use curved lines to round off the sides of the hat. Draw a small line above each foot to finish the legs. Then draw curved and straight lines to add skates.



4

Use curved lines and dots to finish the beak. Then draw lines to round off the skates.
